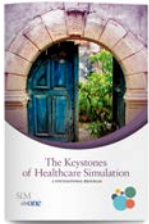


SIM-one Educational Services

BEST PRACTICE TECHNIQUES FOR CLINICAL SIM SCENARIOS



Course Description

This course is an intensive introduction on role-playing for simulations that engage and resonate for learners. Role-playing is a universal high-fidelity technique embedded throughout simulation. This course will teach participants how to create effective roles that align with scenario objectives, and how to develop local resources for creating a standardized patient program.

Participants will develop improved understanding, attitude and skills for the use of role-play and associated techniques for enhancing clinical teaching and learning. Participants will examine how these concepts and exercises can add to their simulations and enhance students' understanding of the content being taught. Participants will have frequent opportunities to compare notes with each other.

The Role-Players Theatre can be used to obtain SIM-one's Keystones and MASCS certificates.

By the end of this course, participants should be familiar with and/or experience the following:

ROLE-PLAY FUNDAMENTALS: Learn essential role-playing terminology for healthcare education-based simulations.

ROLE DEVELOPMENT: Create authentic characters and roles for realistic simulations.



EMBRACE PERFORMANCE: Embrace your inner performer through understanding of role expectations, emotional awareness and regulation skills.

ACTORS & STANDARDIZED PATIENTS: Learn the difference between actors and Standardized Patients (SPs).

PERFORMANCE ANXIETY BLASTERS: Have stage fright? Discover great tips and techniques to deal with performance anxiety.

ROLE-PLAYING FOR DIFFERENT CONTEXTS: Not all simulations go as scripted. Learn about improvisation and role-tweaking methods and techniques.

Intended Participants

This program is designed for educators, simulationists and other interested individuals who want to learn more about scenario writing and creative learning techniques used in simulation-based education. Participants will learn how to incorporate such techniques into their own settings.

NOTE: SIM-one courses fill quickly and the number of participants per course is kept low to allow for optimal faculty/participant engagement.
